Warden's Walk

To celebrate *June is Recreation & Parks Month* in the County of Annapolis, Council and all those in attendance were invited to participate in the Warden's Walk around the block.

2010-2011 Community Recreation Grant Program (CRGP)

Forest Glade Community Club – Municipal Council approved a grant in the amount of \$750 to the Forest Glade Community Club (for a project totalling \$2,250) from the 2010-11 Community Recreation Grant Program.

Round Hill & District Recreation Commission - Municipal Council approved a grant in the amount of \$750 to the Round Hill & District Recreation Commission (for a project totalling \$2,915) from the 2010-11 Community Recreation Grant Program.

Aquatic Facility

Water Art program and Camp Acadia – Municipal Council authorized staff to negotiate access agreements to the aquatic facility with the Water Art program and Camp Acadia.

Annapolis County Fire Services

North Queens Fire Association – Municipal Council has authorized a payment of \$25,000 from the Fire Services Reserve Fund to the North Queens Fire Association on the 2010-11 fiscal year to assist with the purchase of a new utility vehicle.

Bear River Windmill

Bear River Windmill Removal – Municipal Council has approved funding of \$800 towards the removal of the Bear River windmill.

Environment Canada - Municipal Council will provide a letter to our MP and other appropriate political designates supporting the concerns raised by the Municipal Engineer in regards to the Municipal Wastewater strategy.

Upper Clements Park - Municipal Council will provide a letter of support for a Cormorant Helicopter out of CFB Greenwood to do a fly-by on August 21st & 22nd, during Upper Clements Park's "Salute to the Troops" weekend. (9 in favour, 1 against)

RCMP Annapolis District – Municipal Council will support the request of the RCMP to reclassify the uniformed Community Policing Coordinator to that of a uniformed General Duty Investigator.
