# Recreation Activity: GOLF

### Golf Courses:

#### **The Course:**

The original 9 hole course dates back to 1925, with a full 18 holes opened in 1992. All within view of the historic town of Annapolis Royal and the National Historic site of Fort Anne. Several holes offer spectacular views overlooking the Annapolis Basin with the North Mountain of the Annapolis Valley predominant on the horizon. The pro shop makes great use of one of the original barn structures on the property maintaining a rural Valley charm. Besides the views the course is characterized by hilly terrain, dotted with huge glacial boulders and ponds. The course is relatively short and quite open, but offers a full challenge to any golfer.

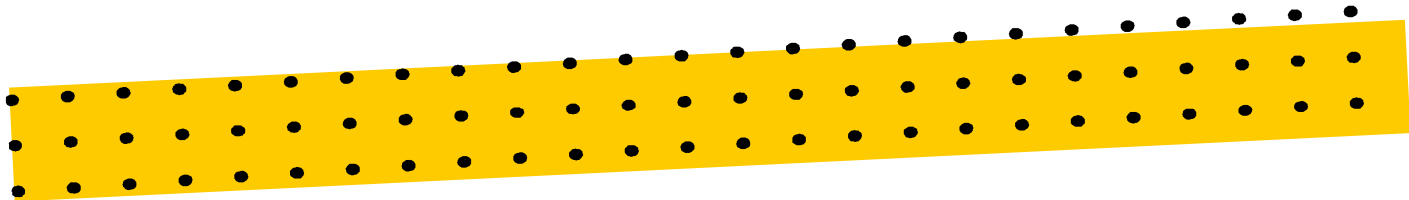

#### **The Course:**

Eden enjoys an extended season which normally runs from early April to late October. The early opening and late closing coupled with the friendly atmosphere, make this course a favorite stop for many Nova Scotian golfers. The 1999 season saw the facility increasing to 18 holes and the additional holes have taken this fine facility from a very nice 9 hole course to a challenging 18 holes. Whether you are visiting from another province or outside Canada, we extend a sincere invitation for you to stop by and enjoy a little bit of Paradise.

Nestled in majestic pines, Eden offers a challenge to the low handicapper as well as the casual golfer. The combination of narrow fairways, small difficult-to-read greens, water hazards, sand bunkers and dog-leg fairways require the player to manage his game and offers premium scores for accurate golf shots.
