BOIL ORDER ADVISORY LIFTED FOR USERS OF MARGARETSVILLE WATER SYSTEM

ANNAPOLIS Co., JULY 29, 2010 - A Boil Order Advisory that had been issued to all users of the Margaretsville Water System has been lifted effective immediately.

Municipal Services Director Laurie Emms said the necessary tests have been completed and it has been determined that the water is ready for consumption.

“We were able to cancel the advisory after receiving two, consecutive bacteriological test results indicating that no bacteria exist in the water sample. The final test result has come in and the water is clean,” said Emms

An Advisory has been issued yesterday after a water sample indicated traces of E.Coli.

“The immediate action of the public works crew was instrumental in addressing this matter in such a timely fashion,” noted Emms. “We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused,” Emms noted.
