ANNAPOLIS COUNTY, NOVEMBER 1, 2011 – As nominations for the Municipality's Special Election closed today, it was confirmed that six individuals filed nomination papers for the position of Councillor for District 7.

The Candidates have until 4:00 p.m. on November 2nd to withdraw their name.

**Polling Day** - will be held on November 26th from 8:00 am until 7:00 p.m. in all four districts: Round Hill (at the Round Hill Hall); Carleton Corner (at the Centrelea Hall); Paradise/W. Paradise (at Jack & Jill Nursery School); and West Dalhousie (at West Dalhousie Hall).

**Advance Polls** - will be held on November 17 and November 22 from noon until 8:00 pm as follows: Round Hill and Carleton Corner at Centrelea Hall; and West Dalhousie and Paradise/W. Paradise at Paradise Hall.

**Voters cards** - will be sent to all 1190 electors in District 7 the third week in November. If you do not receive a card in the mail and you have lived in District 7 for more than 3 months, you may have your name added to the electors list on polling day. You will be asked for identification showing your name, address and signature.

Former Councillor Peter Newton, District 7, resigned on September 30th.
