

**S1 FIRE PREVENTION BYLAW**

1. No person shall burn: brush, rubbish, or other material, or make or burn a bonfire or other fire in a dangerous manner.
2. A fire may not be started except after 6:00 p.m. and before 6:00 a.m.
3. A fire may be started at any time if enclosed within a non-combustible container, for the purpose of cooking food.
4. Anyone starting a fire shall arrange for sufficient help to keep the fire from spreading and to tend it until completely extinguished.
5. Long strips or windrows of brush must be divided into separate piles.
6. Anyone starting a fire shall ensure that a ready supply of water and sufficient tools to control the fire are kept available to control the fire so long as it is burning.
7. No person shall light, ignite, start or permit to burn a fire at any time within 100' of someone else's residence, structure or highway.
8. Any controlled fire under the supervision of a fire department is exempt.
